7. Maintain accurate records and documentation related to research activities and project evaluation.
8. Coordinate project-related meetings, workshops, and training sessions.
9. Stay updated on relevant research trends, publications, and best practices in hospital play services and child life programs.
10. Perform any other duties as assigned by the supervisor or management
