The service helps children to engage in play during their pathway of fighting an illness and being hospitalized, as well as to understand medical procedures, the environment and what is happening in their lives intellectually and psychologically.

Responsibilities

The **Manager, Hospital Play Services** will report to the Executive Director, and will be responsible for:

- outreach and collaboration with local hospitals
- lead the development and strategic direction of hospital play services
- supervise a team of hospital play professionals at a high level of standard
- support the professional development of the team
- contribute to setting training and career paths for the profession
- improve systems to enhance quality output, team productivity and overall efficiency
- explore new resources to support the long-term sustainability of various services provided
- manage the financial resources of the Hospital Play Service Hub to ensure its economic sustainability
- undertake any other duties as assigned by the supervisor

Requirements

Applicants should have:

- Master Degree in healthcare management, childcare, counseling or related fields
- at least 5 years of experience in healthcare related work with management responsibilities
- good networking in the hospital sector is desirable
- knowledge of hospital play services as a definite advantage
- proficiency in computer applications, such as MS Word, Excel and PowerPoint
- good organisational and interpersonal skills
- an open, innovative, self-motivated and responsible attitude
- the ability to work independently and efficiently under pressure

Candidates with less experience may be considered for the position of Deputy Manager, Hospital Play Services.

Salaries will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. The Playright Children's Play Association office practices a five-day work week and offers a comprehensive fringe benefit package. Applications should include a full curriculum vitae, the expected salary, date of availability and the names and email addresses of two referees. Shortlisted candidates will be invited to attend an interview and sit for a written test.
